Sub: Term-End Practical Examinations BSc Sem-VI Regular, Sem-VI & V Reappear 2019-20

Dear Principal,

The UGC Guidelines issued in view of Covid-19 indicate that 'universities may conduct the practical examinations and viva-voce examinations through Skype or other meeting apps. ' for terminal semesters. While NCHM is in the process of finalizing result for theory exam conducted through online mode for final semester of BSc and MSc., practical exams will need to be conducted as well.

Practical exams will be conducted by respective institutes for **regular BSc Semester-VI 2019-20** through online mode using video app. as was done for IT report presentation for second year. Student's mail and mobile phone numbers are available with the institute and there are four subjects requiring practical marks. Hence, the new common practical marking scheme for all the subjects would be:

1. Uniform & Grooming/ Formal 10 marks
2. Journal 10 marks
3. Technical Knowledge/ SOP 25 marks
4. Situation Exercise 25 marks

Total: 70 marks

Institutes may conduct online practical exams through their own date sheet and time so as not to coincide with IGNOU exams. Practical exams may also be conducted for eligible **reappear candidates of Sem-VI and Sem-V** as well for 2019-20. List of such eligible reappear candidates is attached (theory and practical) and you may segregate practical list for your institute. For practical exams, pass marks are 50% as per rules, or 35 marks out of 70. In many cases students may not be in a position to present Journal or be in their correct uniform due to lockdown. Faculty for the subject may decide on the marks to be awarded under these heads, based on performance of the student during regular laboratory classes undertaken at institute.
